That bus will arrive at the Waterbury YMCA between 5:10pm and 5:20pm.

YMCA Camp Mataucha Bus Ratios & Safety Rules

Safety Procedures

YMCA Camp Mataucha uses the following procedures when transporting campers:

1. Buses are loaded only within the passenger seating limit as posted on the vehicle by the vehicle manufacturer.
2. Seatbelts will be worn when the vehicle or bus driver requires.
3. All passengers remain seated while the vehicle is moving.
4. Bus monitors will have a list of all the campers readily available.
5. Persons in wheelchairs are seat belted into wheelchairs that are in locked positions and secured to vehicles, when applicable.
6. Bus ratios, as listed below, will be reevaluated if needed to consider camper age, mental ability and physical condition.

Bus Ratios

YMCA Camp Mataucha uses the following ratios for busing transportation:

20 campers : 1 monitor

20+ campers : 2 monitors

Daily Camper Busing:

At least one bus monitor, trained in bus supervision procedures, will be on each bus

Medical forms are located at YMCA Camp Mataucha

At least one Senior Staff Member is in the Camp Office by 7:00 AM

Bus counselors are trained in CPR/First Aid and Medication Administration
