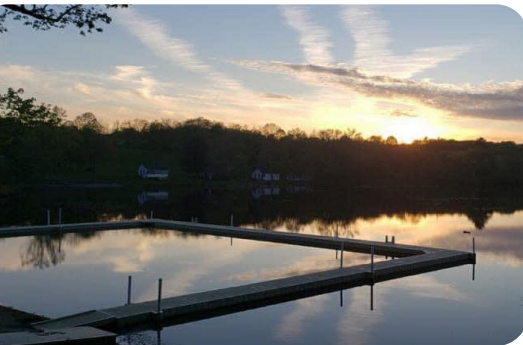

## DIRECTIONS

### Route 8 Northbound

Take Exit 37 and turn left off the exit ramp to second traffic light, turning right onto Buckingham Street. Continue straight through a caution light, traffic light and two stop signs, Fern Hill will change to Smith Pond Road, and the Camp entrance will be on the right.

### Main Street/Route 63 Northbound

Turn right onto Route 6 toward Thomaston. At the traffic light by Westbury Room/Schoolhouse Deli, turn left onto Fern Hill Road. Continue straight through two stop signs, and Fern Hill will change to Smith Pond Road, to Camp entrance on right.

### From Woodbury on Route 6

Continue to the traffic light by Westbury Room/Schoolhouse Deli, turn left onto Fern Hill Road. Continue straight through two stop signs, and Fern Hill will change to Smith Pond Road, the Camp entrance will be on the right.

# WELCOME FRIENDS AND FAMILIES

YMCA Camp Mataucha is a great place for children and youth to develop close friendships, experience new adventures, and make memories to last a lifetime. Our dedication to Youth Development, Health Living, and Social Responsibility has driven us since 1927. Our mission — to put Christian principles into place through programs that develop a healthy spirit, mind, and body for all — remains the focus of our staff and is embodied by our emphasis on the four core character values: Caring, Honesty, Respect, and Responsibility.

## LICENSING & SAFETY

YMCA Camp Mataucha is licensed by the State of Connecticut and is accredited through the American Camp Association (ACA). The ACA collaborates with experts from the American Academy of Pediatrics, the American Red Cross, and other youth service agencies to ensure camps are following the best practices that promote growth and fun in a safe environment for all.

YMCA Camp Mataucha is focused on camper safety. Our staff is trained in First Aid and CPR. During the summer season, we have a nurse on staff and a local physician consultant.

## FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

The YMCA extends financial assistance based upon documented need and availability of funds. Financial Assistance applications will be available beginning April 1st. Applicants are encouraged to apply for a United Way Campership and the State of Connecticut Care-4-Kids childcare subsidy program. United Way Campership Applications are typically available in March.

## HEALTH FORMS

YMCA Camp Mataucha is a state-licensed Day Camp Program. State regulations require all campers to have a physical exam form completed by a physician within the last 36 months on file with the camp office. We also require a health form be completed annually by a parent/guardian. Both forms are required prior to the start of a camper's first session. Campers who require medication will need an individualized care plan, which can be found on our website.

## COVID-19 INFORMATION

There are many traditions at YMCA Camp Mataucha (Family Overnights, Family Nights, etc.) that have been impacted by COVID-19. Current guidelines set by the State of Connecticut may limit some or all of these events. We will be releasing our 2022 Operational Plan on June 1 for all families with more information regarding these events and update families on State and Federal Guidelines for Summer Camps.

Learn to play classic and non-traditional sports with an emphasis on teamwork and good sportsmanship in this minor league-style camp.

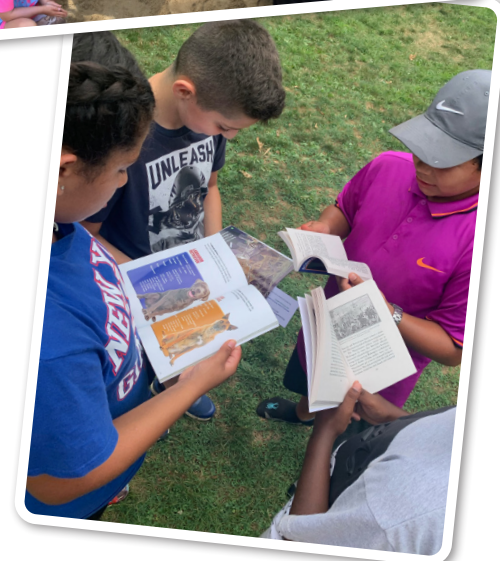
### S.T.E.M CAMP (ENTERING GRADES 2-5 OR 6-9)

## GUARDIAN'S AGREEMENT IMPORTANT — PLEASE READ CAREFULLY. I UNDERSTAND AND AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

- A \$200 non-refundable deposit is required for each child registered for camp and must accompany each application. This deposit will hold the camper's place and will be applied to the total camp tuition.
- Remaining balances are due according to the payment plan selected. Lack of payment for two consecutive months will result in loss of reserved space. EZ payment requires full payment by August 10th.
- Families registered for the EZ Pay system, I hereby authorize the Greater Waterbury YMCA to charge my account monthly, as such amounts become due, without further authorization. The YMCA reserves the right to adjust monthly payments for changes in registration, for uncollected fees, and to terminate this agreement due to nonpayment of camp charges.
- All cancellations must be received IN WRITING 15 days prior to the start of the camp session to receive a refund.
- No refunds will be granted less than 15 days prior to the start of the camp session.
- I will be responsible for payment of any collection fees incurred, should my account become delinquent. An NSF fee of \$25.00 and a late fee of \$25.00 will apply; the fee may be waived if the balance is paid before the last day of the month in which the payment failure occurred.
- Bus service is provided for all campers. Routes for campers are predetermined for specified towns. Each bus will have a YMCA bus monitor. Campers who are entering grades K-4 must be signed out by an authorized guardian or older sibling at the scheduled drop off/pick up time each day unless permission is granted otherwise. Campers entering grades 5 and up can sign themselves off the bus without a guardian present. We ask for a 10 minute grace period for all bus times listed. Any camper who is not signed out will remain on the bus and be transported to either the Greater Waterbury YMCA or YMCA Camp Mataucha and it is the responsibility of the guardian to arrange pick up.
- I give permission for photographs and other recording devices of my camper to be used in marketing and camp publicity.
- Campers must be in good health, injury free and well enough to fully participate.
- I give permission for my camper to participate in all camp activities, including swimming, archery, and climbing tower.
- I authorize YMCA officials to secure medical/emergency treatment and transportation for my camper if deemed necessary.
- The YMCA reserves the right to dismiss a camper whose presence is detrimental to the camp or campers.
- Fees will not be refunded for absence, failure to attend during the term of enrollment, delayed attendance at camp, or dismissal.
- We are required by the State to have health history forms for each camper prior to attending camp. Forms will be given to parents at the time of registration and MUST be completed by the family physician and parents before the camper attends camp. Physicals are valid for three years.
- **The undersigned voluntarily agrees to hold the YMCA harmless for injuries or accidents resulting in bodily injury or property damage during my child's participation at YMCA Camp Mataucha.** I further waive, release, absolve, and indemnify the Greater Waterbury YMCA, YMCA Camp Mataucha, its directors, volunteers, officers or employees for injuries or accidents occurring while participating in the programs of YMCA Camp Mataucha.
- Any unauthorized video, picture, or social media post about YMCA Camp Mataucha, the Waterbury YMCA or their participants is prohibited. It must be removed within 24 hours after notification. Violation of these conditions will result in immediate dismissal without refund.
- I understand that the Greater Waterbury YMCA will be releasing it's COVID Operational Guide on June 1, which will outline any information on any quarantine or cancellation due to COVID-19. I understand that it is my responsibility to review this information prior to my child attending camp.

# IMPORTANT REGISTRATION INFO

Please register early, as many camps and buses fill long before the summer begins. Submission of an application does not guarantee acceptance into camp or a spot on the bus. Acceptance to camp is verified by a confirmation packet that includes a welcome letter, statement of account, health form, and other detailed information. Please provide a separate registration form for each child you are registering. If a prior balance exists on a camper's account, they will not be able to register for the 2022 camp season until the previous balance is paid in full. Any payments made will be applied to previous balances first.

## PAYMENT POLICY

A \$200 non-refundable deposit is required for each child registered for camp and must accompany each application. Registrations will not be processed without a deposit. Payment options include Pay in Full or EZ Pay.

## PAYMENT OPTIONS

### Pay in Full

Families can pay off the entire balance at the time of registration if they choose. Balances must be paid in full by noon on the Friday before the session begins.

### EZ Pay

Provide credit or debit card information (Visa or MasterCard) for EFT, and we will divide your balance into equal, monthly payments that will automatically be charged on the 10th of each month. EZ Pay will begin on the 10th of the month in which you register and will be split into equal payments through August 10th. The earlier you register, the lower your payments will be!
