NEHANTICS	Entering Grades 5–6	\$300 (Each Session)	An exciting program where campers get an in-depth camp experience, which exposes them to advanced camp and craft activities. Our staff will work with campers to develop their strengths, as they work together in group initiatives!

LICENSING AND SAFETY

YMCA Camp Oakasha is licensed by the State of Connecticut and follows the guidelines of the American Camping Assoication. The ACA collaborates with experts from the American Academy of Pediatrics, the American Red Cross, and other youth-serving agencies to ensure camps are following the best practices that promote growth and fun in a safe environment for all.

YMCA Camp Oakasha is focused on camper safety. Our staff is trained in First Aid and CPR. We have a first aider on staff and a local physician consultant during the summer season.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

The YMCA extends financial assistance based upon documented need and availability of funds. Financial Assistance applications will be available beginning April 1st. Applicants are encouraged to apply for a United Way Campership and Care-4-Kids.



YMCA Camp Oakasha is a state-licensed Day Camp Program. State regulations require all campers to have a physical exam form completed by a physician within the last 36 months on file with the Camp Office. We also require a health form to be completed annually by a quardian. Both forms are required before a camper's first day at camp.
