



BUS MEDICATION OPTIONS FORM

Our goal at Camp Mataucha is for an exciting, engaging summer that creates great memories! To meet our goals, we must make sure every part of camp is safe, including bus transportation.

Your child requires medication to ensure an amazing summer. If your child should require medications on the bus, there is a Medication Administration Certified bus monitor on each bus.

We offer two options for medication during bus transportation to and from camp:

- 1.) Have the medications travel with your child on the bus. You sign in the medication with the bus monitor every morning and sign out the medication every afternoon. If the medication is not given to the bus monitor, your child will not be able to ride the bus and will need to be brought to camp with the medication.
- 2.) You may sign stating you do not want your child's medication to travel with them on the bus understanding that if your child should need them, they will not be available. You may choose for your child to sit in the front of the bus by the bus monitor to decrease risk of exposure to allergens and to increase awareness of difficulty breathing.

Please choose the option you are most comfortable with and sign and return this form before the start of your child's camping session.
